

JUDGEMENTS FOLLOWING „THE WALLACHIAN LAW” IN  
BANAT AROUND 1500s  
(Summary)

The author analyzes a list of documents in which the judgement based on the Wallachian Law is mentioned, with „the respect for the local custom”, „the law and tradition of the noble domain of the district” else known as „the Romanian Law”. All these referings are connected with the Romanian unwritten law.

During the Ottoman rulership, the region around Timișoara known as VLAȘKA or Wallachia, term that refers to the province of Banat called like that in 1652 by Evlia Celebi<sup>17</sup>.

The documents were emitted by the bans of Severin in Caransebeș. The term Valachia represents the Latin transliteration of Wallachia used by the locals.
