

PODOABE DIN STICLĂ ÎN DACIA ROMANĂ. CU PRIVIRE SPECIALĂ ASUPRA PIETRELOR DE INEL DIN STICLĂ

Abstract: These ring stones made of glass were manufactured in Roman Dacia, in local workshops from Tibiscum and Porolissum. The 38 pieces presented in this article were discovered in many places from Dacia, such as: one at Tibiscum, Aiton and Apulum, five at Micia and thirty at Porolissum. These pieces were made in a large period of time, between the second and the third centuries. The decorative elements prove once again a circulation of both handcrafts-men/masters and models.
